Even though all residents contribute towards the running costs, it costs more to look after Lightmoor Village than the income we receive. The shortfall is currently funded by BVT to reflect our commitment to making sure Lightmoor Village continues to be a community where people can thrive.

This document shows the estimated budget for 2025 and the costs all residents pay per household. We have included some examples so you can see what the cost is for some of our services weekly.

#### Parks & Landscapes

Lightmoor Village is surrounded by huge amounts of green and open space, with many beautiful parks, play areas, courtyards and trees. It is estimated in 2025 this will cost:

£106,368

This means the cost is £60.60 per household a year, or £1.17p per week



## Community events & activities

Each year there are many community events and activities for residents to get involved with.

It is estimated in 2025 this will cost:

£4,604

This means the cost is £2.62 per household a year, or **5p per week** 



#### Lighting

BVT owns many of the lights and lampposts across Lightmoor Village that will not be adopted by Telford & Wrekin Council.

It is estimated in 2025 this will cost:

£17,800

This means the cost is £10.14 per household a year, or 20p per week

#### **Gritting Service**

Lightmoor Village has a unique gritting service, where we pay a contractor to visit during icy and snowy weather. It is estimated in 2025 this will cost:



This means the cost is £9.91 per household a year, or 19p per week

### Repairs

We want to ensure Lightmoor Village is a safe place to live, repairs can include replacing a broken slab or fence or repairing a swing in one of the play areas. Where possible the Estate Caretakers complete this work, keeping costs to a minimum.

It is estimated in 2025 this will cost:

£14,462

This means the cost is £8.24 per household per year, or 16p per week



#### **Wear & Tear Fund Transfer**

The Wear and Tear Fund collects money for large future expenditures such as new lampposts and bins to large scale block paving replacements or pathway renewals.
